Dear Friends Last Sunday Margaret and Debs (our wardens), Jean Robinson and I went to assess how we could make St. Mary's and St. Thomas and St. John safe for when we eventually open. We stood in our beloved buildings and all of us felt overcome with emotion; I know you will understand. Now, as you will also understand, the situation regarding opening is not clear-cut. Guidance from the Government and the Church/Diocese may change much of what I am about to describe but please read the following points carefully.

- 1) From June 15th churches can open for private prayer however, we do not think this is manageable for our Team as it would require supervision of visitors and cleaning afterwards.
- 2) From June 15th funeral services can be held in churches but this would have to be with strict social distancing and limited numbers. Vergers, organists etc should not be used. I feel that we should only hold a funeral service in church for those who have a strong connection to the church.
- 3) When we can hold services again it is likely that strict social distancing and hygiene practices will be needed: -
 - a) Attendance at St. Mary's will be limited to no more than 37
 - b) Attendance at St. Thomas & St. John will be limited to no more than 55.
 - c) People must sit in the marked seats only and everyone, including those from the same household, will sit at a distance from others
 - d) When you enter you must observe the 2-metre rule and clean your hands (it will be both helpful and safer if you bring your own sanitiser).
 - e) Seating will be filled from the front first e.g. if you arrive first you will go to the front seat, if you arrive last you will be at the back. You cannot sit in your "usual" seat.
 - f) When you leave people sat at the back will leave first.
 - g) There will be no access to kitchen or toilet facilities.
 - h) There will be no Sunday School or social activity post service
 - i) If the church building is empty for 72 hours after a service, there will be no need for additional cleaning but if it is used during that period thorough cleaning will be required.
- 4) At St. Philip's the safety of the pre-school must take precedence and it may be that worship will be delayed.
- 5) At this stage we do not know what our "normal" service will look like. Things that need to be considered include:
 - a) A weekly sheet to replace service and hymn books (sheet to be taken home for disposal)
 - b) Whether or not we can sing?
 - c) Whether the congregation must wear masks?
 - d) Communion????
